Sheriff's Office Investigators thwart Burglary in Progress

Stuyvesant, NY: Sheriff David P. Bartlett reports that two individuals have been arrested for burglarizing a home that is currently being renovated in the Town of Stuyvesant after solid police work by two alert Sheriff's Office Investigators.

Investigators Patrick Logue and Mark Dunspaugh were checking the area of Ferry Road in the Town of Stuyvesant due to recent burglaries that have occurred in the area. They came across two subjects walking along the road and stopped to inquire what they were doing. After interviewing the subjects briefly and attempting to verify what appeared to be inconsistencies with what they had said, further investigation revealed a near-by home was burglarized. The investigators were aware of the fact that this same home had been burglarized in the past and interviewed the subjects further. This lead to admissions by both subjects in regards to the burglarized home.

Investigators Logue and Dunspaugh arrested 22 year old Eugene P. Berhaupt of Rensselaer and 22 year old Zachary W. Dayter of Watervliet and charged them each with a count of Burglary in the Third Degree a class D Felony and Petit Larceny a class A Misdemeanor.

Both suspects were arraigned in the Town of Stuyvesant Court before Judge Carrie O'Hara and released on their own recognizance. They are to return to the Town of Stuyvesant Court on July 2nd, 2014 at 5:00pm.
