Sheriff David P. Bartlett reports that the Certified Child Passenger Safety Technicians from the Columbia County Sheriff's Office and Columbia County Department of Health held a Child Passenger Safety Seat Inspection at the Club Life Day Community event in Kinderhook on Saturday July 18th, 2015 and it was a big success. The Columbia County Sheriff's Office along with the Columbia County Department of Health, and the Valatie Rescue Squad would like to thank the owners and staff of Club Life for all their support as well as the owners and staff of Cantele Tent Rentals for their generous tent donation, which provided shelter for the Child Passenger Safety Seat Inspection.

Technicians assigned to the Child Passenger Safety Seat Program provide new child seats to families who have shown a need, and complete a safety inspection at these events. In addition to a safety seat inspection, parents and caregivers receive free one-to-one installation guidance and safety education from Sheriff's Office and Health Department nationally certified technicians. The program's success is attributed to the grant program itself, as well as the collaboration between the Sheriff's Office and Health Department. A total of 134 safety seats have been inspected and a total of 108 safety seats have been replaced by the grant program. According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 3 out of every 4 safety seats are not installed properly. Other seats may be broken or in some way deficient.

Child seats are provided, (while supplies last), to low-income families who have a demonstrated a need for a child safety seat(s) and meet guidelines set by the New York State Governor's Traffic Safety Committee. Guidelines that must be met before a child safety seat is provided:

- Applicant must have his or her vehicle present
- Applicant must meet income eligibility requirements;
- Applicant must receive education on child passenger safety;
- Applicant must complete the manufacturer's warranty card;

An applicant must sign an agreement and waiver of liability form.
